Key Facts:

Andy Goldsworthy is known for using lots of different natural materials to create beautiful pieces of land art for people to enjoy.

He describes his work as "ephemeral", meaning that it only lasts for a short time.

Goldsworthy works with natural materials, and most of his art is made in the landscape. He has used stone, twigs, leaves and even ice to make his sculptures.

Goldsworthy does not use man-made tools to make his sculptures. He uses things he finds in the landscape, like stones and feathers.

Vocabulary

Land Art	Art that is made in the landscape using natural materials from the environment.
Sculpture	3D Art.
Sculptor	An artist that produces sculptures
Abstract	Not a real representation but uses shapes colours and patterns.
Natural	From nature.
Man-Made	Not from nature, made by humans.
Collage	A work of art that is made by collecting different materials and bringing them together.
Print making	To transfer images and patterns on to a surface to create a piece of art.
Andy Goldsworthy	An English sculptor who also creates land art in different settings.
