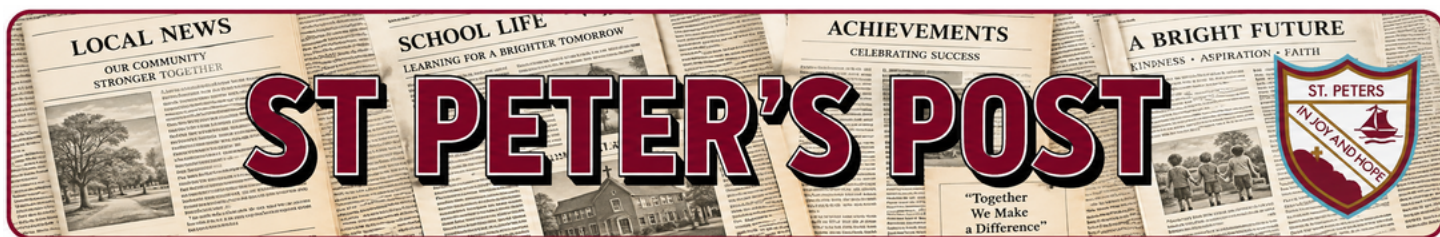

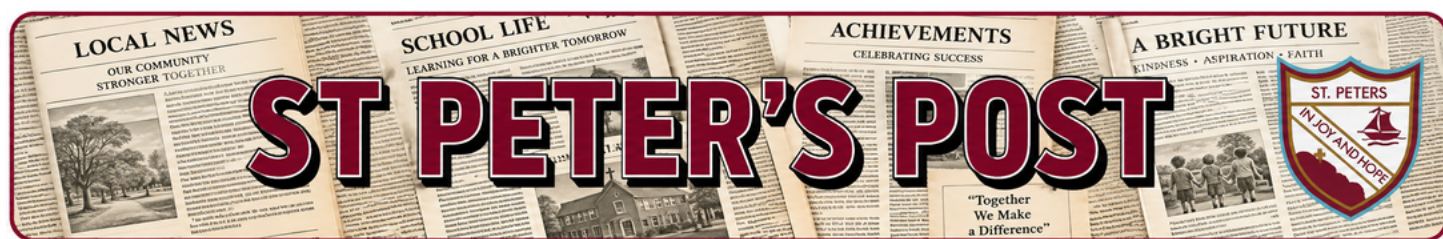

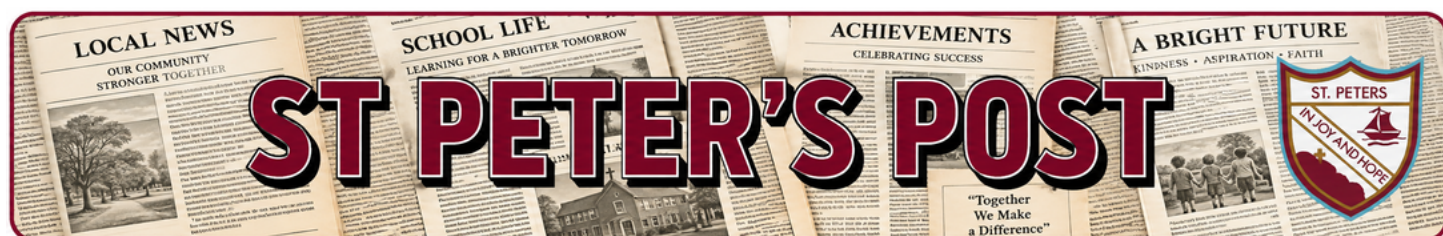
F2 VISIT THE BOOK SHOP

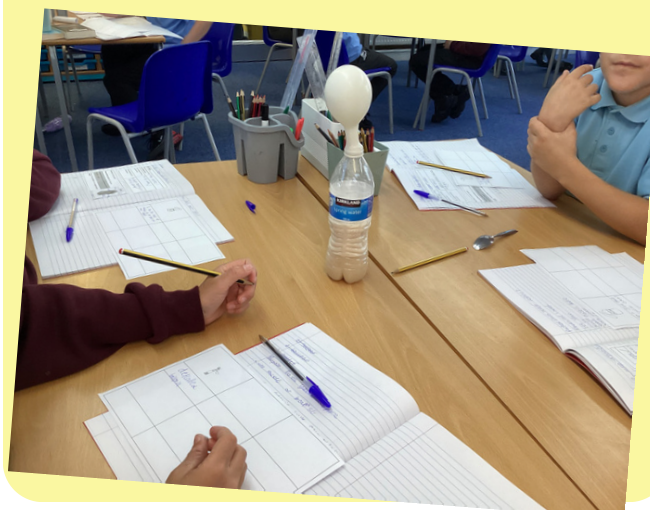

SUPER SCIENTISTS

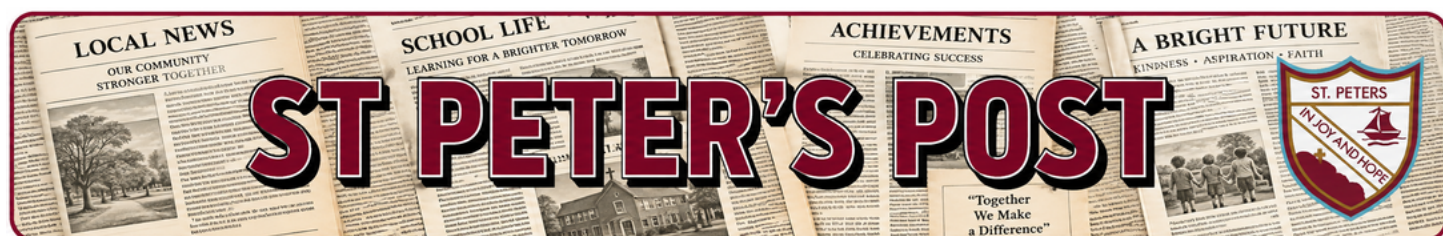

Ways to Beat Head Lice



Ask the pharmacy team what products will work best for you



You need to check the hair for lice at least twice a week, every week



Wet-Combing is the best method of detecting and removing lice and nits



Only use a lice treatment if live lice are actually present in the hair



Make sure to treat every affected family member at the same time

All the new rules coming into force in schools across England from September 2026

Schools to get pupil attendance targets

The Government has said schools in England will be given individual targets to improve pupil attendance. It will see schools given more formalised targets that will be monitored, according to the Department for Education.

New allergy safety rules

As part of Benedict's Law, schools in England will be required to publish their allergy management policies. They will also need to have spare adrenaline auto-injectors available for emergencies, and ensure that all staff members are trained to recognise and respond to allergic emergencies.

School uniform 'rule of three'

Uniforms will be limited to three items with a school logo, like a blazer, jumper or sportswear – plus a tie for secondary schools. The changes will save some families "up to £50 per child".

Free school meals change

From September this year, children in full time education in England will qualify for free school meals, worth around £500 a year per child, if their parents or carers get any amount of Universal Credit.

Mobile phones will be banned

Section 36 of the Children's Wellbeing and Schools Act 2026 has officially come into force, and the restriction covers the whole school day, including during lessons, the time between classes, break times, and lunchtimes.
