Communication & Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening to stories, songs and rhymes • Recognises familiar sounds • Use talk in imaginary play • Listens to others in small groups • Answer simple questions about stories • Understand simple questions • Uses language from some familiar stories
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Holding pencil developing tripod grip • Using scissors • Moving in a range of ways (skipping, jumping, sliding) • Copying letters – initial letter from name • Managing personal hygiene – toilet and washing/drying hands
Understandi ng the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about own families • Begin to understand about changes (Autumn, Winter) • Using ICT equipment such as iPads, iPods, cameras, CD players, bee bots
Expressive Art & Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opportunities for cutting and sticking • Using a variety of different dough • Learning a variety of simple songs • Keeping a beat and simple rhythm • Imaginative play using small world and role play
R.E.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning a simple morning prayer • Learning the signs of the cross
